Los Angeles County Begins Mailing Vote by Mail Ballots for the South Pasadena Unified School District Parcel Tax Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) began mailing Vote by Mail ballots to all registered voters for the South Pasadena Unified School District Parcel Tax Election.

Voters can track their ballot every step of the way with <u>Where's My Ballot?</u> – a free subscription that sends automatic notifications by text, email, or voicemail on the status of the ballot.

When a voter completes their ballot, they must <u>sign and date</u> the Return Envelope, and return the ballot using one of these easy return options:

- Return by mail: No postage is required.
- Ballot Drop Box: A 24-hour drop box is available at the <u>South Pasadena City Hall</u> to return your completed ballot.

The RR/CC provides translated election materials in up to 18 different languages. Voters can request to receive their materials in their preferred language by returning the Language Request Form on the back of the Sample Ballot Book, or by calling (800) 815-2666, option 3.
