First Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the City of Hermosa Beach Special Municipal Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) announced the first post-election ballot count update for the City of Hermosa Beach Special Municipal Election.

The update includes **985** Vote by Mail ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **4,459**, which is **29.51%** of registered voters in the City of Hermosa Beach.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **60** Vote by Mail ballots received via USPS or Ballot Drop Box. These estimates are subject to change throughout the Official Election Canvass period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

The next <u>ballot counting update</u> will be on Tuesday, May 18.
