## First Ballot Counting Update for the Congressional District 25 Special General Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the Congressional District 25 Special General Election.

The update includes **26,019** Vote by Mail ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **133,838**, which is **37.99%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **1,285**.

- Vote by Mail ballots\*: 780
- Conditional Voter Registration ballots: 220
- Provisional ballots: 85
- Misc. ballots\*\*: 200
