First Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the Assembly District 54 Special Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) announced the first post-election ballot count update for the Assembly District 54 Special Primary Election.

The update includes **7,735** ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **42,551**, which is **14.09%** of registered voters in the District.

Full election results can be viewed on LAVote.net.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be processed is **280**, the estimate includes:

- **Vote by Mail ballots***: 277
- **Conditional Voter Registration ballots**: 2
- **Provisional ballots**: 1

Included in the Vote by Mail ballot estimate are those pending signature cures from voters who did not provide their signature on the Return Envelope or the signature does not match the voter's registration record. Those voters have been mailed a notice with instructions on how to cure their ballot.

These estimates are subject to change throughout the Official Election Canvass period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.
