Estimate of Outstanding Ballots to be Processed for City of Compton General Municipal Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) reported a preliminary **estimate** of **2,688** outstanding ballots to be processed during the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period.

The estimate includes Vote by Mail ballots, Conditional Voter Registration (CVR) ballots and Provisional ballots. The RR/CC will continue to accept Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day through Friday (E+3). These additional ballots are not reflected in the estimates below.

- Vote by Mail ballots*: 2,625
- Conditional Voter Registration ballots: 59
- Provisional ballots: 2
- Misc. ballots: 2

These numbers will adjust throughout the canvass period as ballots are processed and counted. Additionally, Vote by Mail and Provisional ballots are subject to verification of voter qualifications before counting.
