Third Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the City of Compton General Municipal Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) announced the third post-election ballot count update for the City of Compton General Municipal Election.

The update includes **8** Vote by Mail ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **8,694**, which is **17.97%** of registered voters in the City of Compton.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be processed is **154** Vote by Mail ballots pending signature cures from voters who did not provide their signature on the Return Envelope, or the signature on the Return Envelope did not match the voter's registration record. All impacted voters have been mailed a notice with instructions on how to cure their ballot.

Election results are scheduled to be certified on Monday, June 14.
