## First Ballot Counting Update for the June 2 Special Elections

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the June 2 Special Elections.

The update includes **1,722** Vote by Mail and Vote Center ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **7,316**, which is **17.89%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

An estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is 53.

- Misc. ballots\*\*: 8
