First Election Results Update for the Senate District 33 Special General Election and Municipal and Special Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the Senate District 33 Special General Election and Municipal and Special Elections.

The update includes **68,067** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **414,359**, which is **14.61%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **31,708** consisting of the following:

- Provisional ballots: 28,160
- Vote by Mail ballots*: 2,605
- Misc. ballots**: 930
- Conditional Voter Registration: 13

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through today (E+3). These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election</u> <u>Canvass</u>.
