Certified Election Results for Senate District 33 Special General Election and Third Election Results Update for the Municipal and Special Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the certified election results for the Senate District 33 Special General Election and the third ballot counting update for the Municipal and Special Elections held on June 4.

The update includes **2,453** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Provisional and Vote by Mail ballots. The total ballot count is now **443,656**, which is **15.64%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters within the jurisdictions involved in the elections. The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted for the Municipal and Special Elections is:

Provisional ballots: 1,840Vote by Mail ballots: 800

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through today (E+3). These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election</u> <u>Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process VBM envelopes.
