Last Day to Request a Vote by Mail Ballot for the June Statewide Direct Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds voters in Los Angeles County that **tonight at 11:59PM** is the deadline to request a Vote by Mail (VBM) ballot.

As of today, the RR/CC has issued **2,285,560** Vote by Mail ballots. Voters can request a Vote by Mail ballot by:

- Applying online at <u>lavote.net</u>
- Returning the VBM application on the back of the Sample Ballot
- Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot in person at the RR/CC headquarters: <u>12400 Imperial Highway</u>, 3rd Floor (Room 3002), Norwalk CA 90650

Voters can check the status of their VBM ballot online at lavote.net.

There are over 100 VBM drop-off locations spread throughout the County for voters to drop off their ballot in-person. Find your nearest <u>VBM drop-off location</u>.

All VBM ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (E.C. § 3020).
