Fifth Election Results Update for the Statewide Direct Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the fifth ballot counting update for the Statewide Direct Primary Election.

The update includes **83,447** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and Provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **1,362,267**, which is **26.50%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted:

Provisional ballots: 96,000Vote by Mail ballots: 43,500

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through today (E+3). These results are subject to change throughout the Official Election Canvass period as our canvass staff process VBM envelopes.
