## Third Election Results Update for the Statewide Direct Primary Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the third ballot counting update for the Statewide Direct Primary Election.

The update includes **58,355** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and Provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **1,238,827**, which is **24.10%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted:

Provisional ballots: 115,700Vote by Mail ballots\*: 123,100

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through today (E+3). These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election</u> <u>Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process VBM envelopes.
