Vote by Mail Request Period Ending for the June 6th Congressional District 34 Special General Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds voters in Congressional District 34 that the last day to request a Vote by Mail ballot is **Tuesday, May 30**<sup>th</sup>.

As of today, the RR/CC have issued **121,871** Vote by Mail ballots. To learn more about this election view our **Congressional District 34 Special General Election Fact Sheet**.

Voters who wish to request a Vote by Mail ballot can:

- Apply online at lavote.net
- Use the application on the back of their Sample Ballot
- Request a Vote by Mail ballot in person at the RR/CC headquarters: <u>12400 Imperial Highway</u>, 3<sup>rd</sup>
  Floor (Room 3002), Norwalk CA 90650

Voters who applied for a Vote by Mail ballot can check the status of their ballot online at lavote.net.

There are four Vote by Mail drop-off locations spread throughout the district. Find the nearest <u>drop-off</u> location.

Beginning January 1, 2015 all Vote by mail ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (E.C. § 3020).
