Additional Vote Centers Open on Second Weekend of Early Voting for June Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced an additional 522 Vote Centers are open on the second weekend of early voting in the June Primary Election.

A total of 642 Vote Centers are open daily from 10 AM to 7 PM for safe in-person voting, or to return a completed Vote by Mail ballot. All Vote Centers will follow <u>current public health and safety guidelines</u>.

A full list and online map of Vote Center locations are available online at LOCATOR.LAVOTE.GOV.

The June Primary Election ballot includes a lot of contests and candidates. Voters can save time when they vote in person by using the Poll Pass.

The Poll Pass is an optional tool that allows voters the option to review and mark their selections before visiting a Vote Center.

The safest way to participate in this election is to return the Vote by Mail ballot by mail (no postage required), to an Official Ballot Drop Box, or at a Vote Center.
