Vote Centers Open in the June Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced Vote Centers are open in the June Primary Election.

A total of 643 Vote Centers are open from 7 AM to 8 PM for safe in-person voting, or to return a completed Vote by Mail ballot. All Vote Centers will follow <u>current public health and safety guidelines</u>.

A full list and online map of Vote Center locations are available online at LOCATOR.LAVOTE.GOV.

Media who want to visit a Vote Center must complete the <u>Media at the Vote Center Request Form</u> before arrival.

This ballot includes a lot of contests and candidates. Voters can save time when they vote in person by using the <u>Poll Pass</u>.

The Poll Pass is an optional tool that allows voters the option to review and mark their selections before visiting a Vote Center.

The safest way to participate in this election is to return the Vote by Mail ballot by mail (no postage required), to an <u>Official Ballot Drop Box</u>, or at a <u>Vote Center</u>.
