Semi-Final Results Announced for the June Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced semi-final results for the June Primary Election.

A total of **822,545** ballots were processed and counted, with **14.45%** of registered voters casting ballots.

Election results are available to view and download at <u>LAVOTE.GOV</u>.

After Election Day there are still many outstanding ballots to be processed and counted in the Official Election Canvass.

During the Official Election Canvass all Conditional Voter Registration ballots, Provisional ballots, and Vote by Mail ballots received on Election Day are processed. Once the ballots are verified they will be counted.

The first post-election ballot count update is scheduled for Friday, June 10. The full schedule of ballot counting updates is available on the <u>Canvass Update Schedule</u>.
