First Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the San Marino Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) announced the first post-election ballot count update for the San Marino Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election.

The update includes **460** ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **4,783**, which is **46.21%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters residing in the district.

Full election results can be viewed on <u>LAVote.net</u>.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be processed is 68, the estimate includes:

- Vote by Mail ballots*: 67
- Provisional ballots: 1

Included in the Vote by Mail ballot estimate are those pending signature cures from voters who did not provide their signature on the Return Envelope or the signature does not match the voter's registration record. Those voters have been mailed a notice with instructions on how to cure their ballot.

These estimates are subject to change throughout the Official Election Canvass period as our canvass staff process outstanding ballots.

The next <u>ballot counting update</u> will be on Tuesday, July 6.
