Semi-Final Results Announced for San Marino Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced semi-official results for the San Marino Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election.

A total of 4,323 ballots were processed and counted, with 41.76% of registered voters casting ballots.

After Election Day there are still many outstanding ballots to be processed and counted during the Official Election Canvass. All Vote by Mail ballots received on Election Day will be processed. Once the ballots are verified, they will be counted.

Ballots postmarked by Election Day must be returned to our Norwalk Headquarters within three (3) days of Election Day to be processed.

The first post-election ballot count update is scheduled for Friday, July 2. The full schedule of ballot counting updates is available on the <u>Canvass Update Schedule</u>.
