Vote by Mail Ballots Mailed for the Norwalk-La Mirada Unified School District Special Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) began mailing Vote by Mail ballots to all eligible registered voters in the Norwalk-La Mirada Unified School District for the July 20 Special Election.

Voters can track the mailing of their Vote by Mail ballot with Where's My Ballot.

We encourage voters to safely participate in this election by returning their mail-in ballot early. There are several safe return options available:

- Return by mail, no postage required must be postmarked by Election Day
- Drop off at a Ballot Drop Box
- Drop off at a <u>Vote Center</u> Beginning July 10th

Starting today, voters can visit the RR/CC Headquarters in <u>Norwalk</u> to safely vote early in-person. All public health and safety guidelines will be followed, and voters will be required to wear a facial covering.
