### Last Day to Request a Vote by Mail Ballot for the August 7<sup>th</sup> Senate District 32 Special General Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds voters in Senate District 32 that **tomorrow at 11:59PM** is the deadline to request a Vote by Mail (VBM) ballot.

As of today, the RR/CC has issued **200,142** Vote by Mail ballots. Voters can request a Vote by Mail ballot by:

- Applying online at [lavote.net](http://lavote.net)
- Returning the VBM application on the back of the Sample Ballot
- Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot in person at the RR/CC headquarters: [12400 Imperial Highway, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor \(Room 3002\), Norwalk CA 90650](#)

There are 10 VBM drop-off locations within the district for voters to drop off their ballot in-person. Find your nearest [VBM drop-off location](#).

All VBM ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk ([E.C. § 3020](#)).
