Vote by Mail Ballots Mailed for the August 7th Senate District 32 Special General Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) began mailing **186,750** Vote by Mail (VBM) ballots for the August 7th Senate District 32 Special General Election.

Voters can request a Vote by Mail (VBM) ballot online or by using the back of the Official Sample Ballot.

Once you return the VBM ballot you can check the <u>VBM ballot status</u> online.

There are 10 VBM Drop-Off locations open for VBM voters to securely drop off their ballot in-person. Find the nearest location to you.

Early voting is also available at our office in **Norwalk** on the 3rd floor.

All VBM ballots postmarked on, or before, Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the RR/CC (E.C. § 3020).
