Vote Centers Open on Election Day in the California Gubernatorial Recall Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced Vote Centers are open and ready for voting in the California Gubernatorial Recall Election.

Vote Centers are open from 7 AM to 8 PM for safe in-person voting or to return a completed Vote by Mail ballot. All Vote Centers will follow public health and safety guidelines.
