## First Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the California Gubernatorial Recall Election

**LOS ANGELES** – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) announced the first post-election ballot count update for the California Gubernatorial Recall Election.

The update includes **236,397** ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **2,499,468**, which is **43.92%** of registered voters. Election results can be viewed on <u>LAVote.net</u>.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots to be processed is 292,995. See estimates below:

Vote by Mail ballots: 276,205

Conditional Voter Registration ballots: 15,320

• Provisional ballots\*: 970

Misc. ballots\*\*: 500

The Vote by Mail ballot estimate includes ballots received on Wednesday (E+1) and Thursday (E+2), and that are pending signature cures from voters whose signature did not match their voter registration record or was missing. Those voters have been notified with instructions on how to cure their ballot.

The RR/CC will continue to accept Vote by Mail ballots that are postmarked by Election Day and received through Tuesday, September 21 (E+7). These ballots are not included in the estimate.

All outstanding ballots are verified before being tallied. These numbers will adjust throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> as we receive, process, and tally ballots.

The next post-election <u>ballot count</u> will be on Tuesday, September 21. The full schedule of election result updates can be viewed on the <u>Canvass Update Schedule</u>.
