Preliminary Estimate of Outstanding Ballots Left to be Processed

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the preliminary estimate of outstanding ballots left to be processed in the California Gubernatorial Recall Election.

This estimate includes Vote by Mail ballots, Conditional Voter Registration ballots, and Provisional ballots at the Vote Center. See estimates below:

- Vote by Mail ballots: 255,000
- Conditional Voter Registration ballots: 17,800
- Provisional ballots*: 1,100
- Misc. ballots**: 500

The RR/CC will continue to accept Vote by Mail ballots that are postmarked by Election Day and received through Tuesday, September 21 (E+7). These ballots are not included in the preliminary estimate.

All outstanding ballots are verified before being tallied. These numbers will adjust throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> as we receive, process, and tally ballots.

The first post-election results update will be released Friday, September 17. The full schedule of postelection result updates can be viewed on the <u>Canvass Update Schedule</u>.
