Sixth Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the California Gubernatorial Recall Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) announced the sixth post-election ballot count update for the California Gubernatorial Recall Election.

The update includes **1,254** ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **2,938,649**, which is **51.64%** of registered voters. Election results can be viewed on <u>LAVote.net</u>.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots to be processed is **21,900**. See estimates below:

Vote by Mail ballots: 19,000

Conditional Voter Registration ballots: 2,800

• Provisional ballots*: 100

The estimated number of outstanding Vote by Mail ballots includes those postmarked by Election Day and received by September 21 (E+7). The estimate also includes ballots that are pending signature cures from voters whose signature on the Return Envelope was missing or did not match their registration record. These voters have been notified with instructions on how to cure their ballot.

All outstanding ballots are verified before being tallied. These numbers will adjust throughout the Official Election Canvass as we process and tally ballots.

The next post-election <u>ballot count</u> will be on Friday, October 8. The full schedule of election result updates can be viewed on the <u>Canvass Update Schedule</u>.
