Vote by Mail Ballots Mailed for Assembly District 51 Special Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) mailed **82,742** Vote by Mail (VBM) Ballots for the October 3rd Assembly District 51 Special Primary Election.

Request a Vote by Mail ballot <u>online</u>, or by using the back of the Official Sample Ballot.

Check the status of your VBM ballot by visiting lavote.net.

VBM Drop-Off sites are available in two locations within the district. Find the nearest location.

VBM voters who choose to vote at their polling place on Election Day must bring their ballot to surrender, or they will be asked to cast a Provisional Ballot.

Early voting is now available at our office in <u>Norwalk</u> on the 3rd floor. Weekend Early Voting will also be available at the **East Los Angeles County Library** and **Cypress Park Branch Library** on September 30 and October 1 from 8am-4pm.

Beginning January 1, 2015 all Vote by mail ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (E.C. § 3020).
