Enhanced Public Access to Search Historical Real Estate Records at Lancaster District Office

LOS ANGELES — Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the RR/CC Lancaster District Office has expanded its in-person services to provide the public with access to search and view real estate records dating from 1982 to the present using designated lobby kiosks.

Supervisor Kathryn Barger applauded this expansion of services. "I am pleased that our County's Registrar-Recorder has expanded the in-person help offered to my North County constituents," said Supervisor Barger. "Finding older property records can be a daunting task, and some indivdiuals need support to do so. I'm hopeful the public at large will take advantage of the personal support that is now being offered."

Individuals can utilize the new kiosk service Monday through Thursday from 8:30 AM to 12:00 PM. For more efficient service delivery, individuals can avoid waiting in lobby lines by <u>reserving an appointment</u> online to use the kiosks.

Real estate records prior to 1982 are available to view at the <u>RR/CC Headquarters in Norwalk</u>. The Department will expand kiosk access as additional records are digitized going forward.

The RR/CC is committed to ensuring accessibility and ease of use for all residents, and this expansion is a testament to that commitment.
