Additional Vote Centers Open for November 2 Local and Municipal Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced additional Vote Centers are open and available for voting for the November 2 Local and Municipal Elections.

Vote Centers are open daily from 10 AM to 7 PM to safely vote in person or to return a completed Vote by Mail ballot. Vote Centers will follow current public health and safety guidelines.

Voter Resources:

- <u>Quick Check-in Code</u>: Speed up Vote Center check-in (also printed on the Sample Ballot book)

The safest way to participate in this election is to return the Vote by Mail ballot by mail (no postage required) or drop off the ballot at any participating <u>Ballot Drop Box</u> or Vote Center.
