First Post-Election Ballot Count Update for the Local and Municipal Elections

LOS ANGELES – The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) announced the first post-election ballot count update for the Local and Municipal Elections.

The update includes **5,916** ballots processed since Election Night. The total election results count is now **27,829**, which is **12.67%** of registered voters. Election results can be viewed on <u>LAVote.net</u>.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots to be processed is **180**. See estimates below:

- Vote by Mail ballots: 165
- Provisional ballots*: 10
- Misc. ballots**: 5

The RR/CC will continue to accept Vote by Mail ballots that are postmarked by Election Day and received through Tuesday, November 9 (E+7). These ballots are not included in the estimate.

All outstanding ballots are verified before being tallied. These numbers will adjust throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> as we receive, process, and tally ballots.
