Fourth Post-Election Results Update in the Presidential General Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the fourth post-election results update in the Presidential General Election.

The update includes **428,221** Vote by Mail ballots and **2,980** Vote Center ballots processed since Election Night and consists of ballots received via USPS and dropped off at an Official Ballot Drop Box or Vote Center through Election Day, November 3.

The total election results count is now **4,153,568**, which is **72.74**% of eligible Los Angeles County voters. View and download election results on <u>lavote.net</u>.

An updated estimate of outstanding ballots left to be counted will be released this evening and will include the most up-to-date estimate of ballots received in today's USPS mail delivery, ballots returned in Ballot Drop Boxes or those returned at Vote Centers.

The fifth results update will be released Tuesday, November 10. The full schedule of election results updates can be viewed on the Canvass Update Schedule.
