Second Post-Election Results Update in the Presidential General Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second post-election results update in the Presidential General Election.

The update includes **156,410** Vote by Mail ballots processed since Election Night, and consists of ballots received since Sunday, November 1 via USPS or dropped off at a drop box or Vote Center.

The total election results count is now **3,538,953**, which is **61.98**% of eligible Los Angeles County voters. View and download election results on <u>lavote.net</u>.

The preliminary estimate of outstanding ballots left to be counted will be released this evening including the most up-to-date estimate of ballots received in today's USPS mail delivery, ballots returned in Ballot Drop Boxes or those returned at Vote Centers.
