## Second Election Results Update for the November 5 Local and Municipal Elections

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second ballot counting update for the November 5 Local and Municipal Elections.

The update includes **509** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and Provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **46,062**, which is **22.09%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters across all participating jurisdictions.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **15** consisting of the following:

- Vote by Mail ballots\*: 10
- Misc. ballots\*\*: 5

This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through last Friday. These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election</u> <u>Canvass</u> period as the Department's canvass staff process VBM envelopes.
