Second Election Results Update for the November 6 General Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second ballot counting update for the November 6 General Election.

The update includes **270,251** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **2,369,109**, which is **45.56**% of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **688,000** consisting of the following:

Provisional ballots: 405,000Vote by Mail ballots*: 275,000

• Misc. ballots**: 4,000

Conditional Voter Registration: 4,000

These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process VBM envelopes and de-process precinct supplies. This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through last Friday.
