## Third Election Results Update for the November 6 General Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the third ballot counting update for the November 6 General Election.

The update includes **262,933** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **2,632,042**, which is **50.61%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

The estimated number of outstanding ballots left to be counted is **422,600** consisting of the following:

- Provisional ballots: 355,000
- Vote by Mail ballots\*: 63,000
- Misc. ballots\*\*: 600
- Conditional Voter Registration: 4,000

These results are subject to change throughout the <u>Official Election Canvass</u> period as our canvass staff process VBM envelopes and de-process precinct supplies. This estimate includes additional Vote by Mail Ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received through last Friday.
