Polls Closed and First Ballot Count for the Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the closing of the polls for today's local and municipal consolidated elections.

The first Election Night ballot count includes **37,162** returned Vote by Mail ballots out of **287,355** Vote by Mail ballots issued in the district.

Updates to the tally will be made throughout the evening as ballots arrive from all **253** polling places to Norwalk Headquarters for central tabulation.
