First Election Results Update for the Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot counting update for the Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections.

The update includes **11,469** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail and provisional ballots. The total election results count is now **72,736**, which is **11.69%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.
