Vote by Mail Request Period Ending for the Nov. 7th Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds voters that the last day to request a Vote by Mail ballot is **Tuesday, October 31**st.

As of today, the RR/CC have issued **284,957** Vote by Mail ballots. To learn more about this election view our <u>Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections Fact Sheet</u>.

Voters who wish to request a Vote by Mail ballot can:

- Apply online at lavote.net
- Use the application on the back of their Sample Ballot
- Request a Vote by Mail ballot in person at the RR/CC headquarters: <u>12400 Imperial Highway</u>, 3rd
 <u>Floor (Room 3002)</u>, Norwalk CA 90650

Voters who applied for a Vote by Mail ballot can check the status of their ballot online at lavote.net.

There are 17 Vote by Mail drop-off locations spread throughout the County. Find the nearest <u>drop-off</u> <u>location</u>.

Beginning January 1, 2015 all Vote by mail ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three (3) days by the by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (E.C. § 3020).
