Semi-Final Results Announced for the 2022 General Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced semi-final results for the 2022 General Election.

A total of **1,318,093** ballots were processed and counted, with **23.42%** of registered voters casting ballots.

Election results are available to view and download at <u>LAVOTE.GOV</u>.

After Election Day there are still many outstanding ballots to be processed and counted in the Official Election Canvass.

During the Official Election Canvass, all Vote by Mail, Conditional, and Provisional ballots received on Election Day are processed and verified. Once verified, they will be counted.

The first post-Election Day ballot count update is scheduled for Friday, November 11. The full schedule of ballot counting updates is available on the <u>Canvass Update Schedule</u>.
