Second Election Results Update for the Assembly District 51 Special General Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second ballot counting update for the Assembly District 51 Special General Election.

The update includes **10** ballots processed since Election Night, consisting of Vote by Mail ballots. The total election results count is now **20,887**, which is **9.47%** of eligible Los Angeles County voters.

Voters who returned their Vote by Mail ballot unsigned have eight (8) days from Election Day to sign and return an Unsigned Ballot Statement that our office sends to the voter. The next ballot counting update will be on **Thursday, December 12**, if necessary.
