#### Touchscreen Early Voting Now Available in Norwalk

Although the ten countywide early voting sites do not begin operation until October 26, Early Voting on touchscreen equipment is now available for any Los Angeles County voter at our headquarters in Norwalk during regular business hours, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Early voting continues through November 4 countywide, and through 8 p.m. Election Day in Norwalk.

#### **Voter Registration Deadline**

Monday, October 24 is the deadline for voter registration for the November 8 Special Statewide and Consolidated Elections. There are currently 3,830,529 registered voters.

#### Sample Ballots

Mailings of Sample Ballots continue with 80% of the total mailing complete as of today. Mailing to current registered voters is anticipated to be completed October 18. Voters registering now through October 24 will be also be mailed sample ballots as they register.

#### **Absentee Ballot Mailings**

To date, we have mailed 356,000 absentee ballots. The deadline to apply for an absentee ballot is November 1.

This election will involve 2,172 precincts requiring the recruitment of approximately 12,000 pollworkers. Recruitment of precinct officers is proceeding on schedule.

3. <u>Update Registration Records</u> 10/24/05

The October 6, 2005 update of the registration records total 3,830,529 registered voters. This event is proceeding on schedule.

4. <u>Testing of Election Night Data</u> 11/07/05 <u>Processing Hard/Ware and Programs</u>

Testing of election night tally programs is in process. This event is proceeding on schedule.

6. <u>Mail Sample Ballots</u> 10/18/05

The initial and supplemental sample ballot mailing to over 3.8 million registered voters began on September 29, 2005 and will continue through October 18, 2005. This event is proceeding on schedule.

7. <u>Precinct Supplies and Vote Recorders</u> 10/24/05 <u>Assembled</u>

Vote Recorder Packaging will begin on October 14, 2005. Supply box processing will commence on October 24, 2005.

8. <u>Booth and Supplies Picked-Up</u> 10/30/05 <u>By Precinct Inspectors</u>

Booths and supplies are scheduled for pick-up on October 29 - 30, 2005.
