More Than 15,000 Vote by Mail Ballots Sent to Pomona Residents
Application Period Begins Today for Vote by Mail Ballots

More than 15,000 Vote by Mail ballots were sent out to Pomona residents for the March 12 Senate District 32 Special Primary Election today. The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) reminds Pomona residents that the last day to request a Vote by Mail ballot is Tuesday, March 5.

Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot is easy and can be done <u>online</u> or by using the back of the official sample ballot. Registered voters can also apply in person at the RR/CC's main office: 12400 Imperial Hwy., 3rd floor, Room 3002, Norwalk, CA 90650.
