Vote by Mail Request Period Ending for Bell & Cudahy Elections
The deadline to request a Vote by Mail ballot is Feb. 26

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan reminds voters to request a Vote by Mail ballot for the Bell and Cudahy elections by Tuesday, Feb. 26. The Consolidated Elections take place on Tuesday, March 5.

To date, the RR/CC has mailed over 4,300 Vote by Mail ballots to the residents of Bell and Cudahy. Collectively, there are nearly 18,000 registered voters in Bell and Cudahy.

Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot is easy and can be done <u>online</u> or by using the back of the official sample ballot.

Vote by Mail ballots must be received by the L.A. County RR/CC in Norwalk by 8 p.m. on the day of the election. Voters can drop off or mail their ballot to RR/CC headquarters in Norwalk or drop their ballot off at any polling place location in L.A. County on Election Day between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. Postmarked envelopes are not accepted.
