Register to Vote by Feb. 25 for the SD 32 Special Primary Election

Feb. 25 is the last to register to vote in the Senate District 32 Special Primary Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan reminds Pomona residents that the deadline to register to vote in the upcoming election is Monday, Feb. 25. The Senate District 32 Special Primary Election takes place on Tuesday, March 12.

The 32nd state senate district is comprised of Montclair, Colton, Montana, Ontario, Rialto, San Bernardino, Chino and Pomona. The RR/CC is conducting the election for the city of Pomona, which has about 58,000 registered voters to date.

There are several options to register to vote:

- Apply online at <u>www.lavote.net</u>.
- Apply in person at the RR/CC's Norwalk office: 12400 Imperial Highway.
- A paper voter registration application at public libraries, Department of Motor Vehicles offices, U.S. post offices and most government buildings.
