Vote by Mail Request Period Ending for Senate District 32 Special Primary Election The deadline to request a Vote by Mail ballot is March 5

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan reminds voters to request a Vote by Mail ballot by Tuesday, March 5. The Senate District 32 Special Primary Election is on Tuesday, March 12.

To date, the RR/CC has mailed more than 15,800 Vote by Mail ballots, which represent over 25 percent of the active registered voters in Pomona. There are more than 58,000 active registered voters in Pomona.

The 32nd state senate district is comprised of Chino, Colton, Montana, Montclair, Ontario, Pomona, Rialto and San Bernardino. The RR/CC is conducting the election for the city of Pomona.

Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot is easy and can be done <u>online</u> or by using the back of the official sample ballot.

Vote by Mail ballots must be received by the L.A. County RR/CC in Norwalk by 8 p.m. on the day of the election. Voters can drop off or mail their ballot to RR/CC headquarters in Norwalk or drop their ballot off at any polling place location in L.A. County on Election Day between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. Postmarked envelopes are not accepted.

L.A. County residents who vote by mail can check the status of their ballot online.
