March 12, 2013 Senate District 32 Special Primary Election First Ballot Count Update

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced the first ballot count update for the Senate District 32 Special Primary Election on March 12, 2013.

As of 8 p.m. on March 12, 3,169 ballots were counted. This initial number represents the vote by mail ballots received and processed by the RRCC. It is important to note we share this election with San Bernardino County, you can find their elections results here.

The Official Election Canvass period begins on Wednesday, March 13 and ends on Friday, March 15. During the Official Canvass, all outstanding provisional and Vote by Mail ballots will be verified and tallied. The RR/CC will also conduct a 1% Manual Audit.

On Friday, March 15, the RR/CC is scheduled to certify the election results. On Monday, March 25, the RR/CC is tentatively scheduled to certify the results for the California Secretary of State. There are no further updates scheduled at this time.
