### **March 12, 2013 Special Elections Final Official Election Results Reported**

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean Logan announced certified official election results for the March 12, 2013 Special Elections, with 18.06% of eligible registered voters casting ballots. A total of 15,342 ballots were counted during the Official Election Canvass period. For specific tallies, visit [www.lavote.net](http://www.lavote.net).

The March 12, 2013 Special Elections include the Senate District 32 Special Primary Election, the San Marino Unified School District Parcel Tax Election and the South Pasadena Unified School District Parcel Tax Election.

The Official Election Canvass period began on Wednesday, March 13 and ended on Monday, March 18. During the Official Canvass, all outstanding provisional and Vote by Mail ballots were verified and tallied. The RR/CC also conducted the 1% Manual Audit.

On Tuesday, March 26, the Board of Supervisors is scheduled to tentatively declare the election results official for the San Marino Unified School District Parcel Tax Election and the South Pasadena Unified School District Parcel Tax Election.
