May 14, 2013 Senate District 32 Special General Election First Ballot Count Update

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC), Dean Logan, announced the first ballot count update for the Senate District 32 Special General Election on May 14, 2013.

As of 8 p.m., 3,484 ballots were counted. This initial figure represents the Vote by Mail Ballots received and processed by the RR/CC. It is important to note this election is shared with San Bernardino County. The next scheduled update is at 10 p.m.

The Official Election Canvass period begins on Wednesday, May 15 and ends on Friday, May 24. During the Official Canvass, all outstanding provisional and Vote by Mail ballots will be verified and tallied. The RR/CC will also conduct a 1% Manual Audit. During this period, the RR/CC is scheduled to release the Final Official Results.

On Wednesday, May 29, the RR/CC is tentatively scheduled to certify the results to the California Secretary of State.
