RR/CC Begins Mailing Assembly District 52 Vote by Mail Ballots to Pomona Voters

Special Primary Election Scheduled on July 23, 2013

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) began mailing more than 15,000 Vote by Mail ballots to Pomona voters for the July 23, 2013 Assembly District 52 Special Primary Election. The RR/CC reminds Pomona residents that the last day to request a Vote by Mail ballot is Tuesday, July 16.

Nearly 39,000 sample ballot booklets were mailed on June 21, 2013.

Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot is easy and can be done <u>online</u> or by using the back of the official sample ballot. Registered voters can also apply in person at the RR/CC's main office: 12400 Imperial Hwy., 3rd floor, Room 3002, Norwalk, CA 90650.
