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Pomona Residents Have Until Sept. 17 to Request a Vote by Mail Ballot Assembly District 52 Special General Election Scheduled on Sept. 24, 2013

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds voters to request a Vote by Mail ballot by Tuesday, Sept. 17 for the Assembly District 52 Special General Election on Sept. 24, 2013. The application period for requesting a Vote by Mail ballot begins today.

The RR/CC began mailing about 13,000 Vote by Mail Ballots to voters today. In addition, the RR/CC will mail about 42,000 Sample Ballot Booklets.

Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot is easy and can be done <u>online</u> or by using the back of the official sample ballot. Registered voters can also apply in person at the RR/CC's main office: 12400 Imperial Hwy., 3rd floor, Room 3002, Norwalk, CA 90650.
