Vote by Mail Request Period Ending for the Nov. 5, 2013 Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections

The deadline to request a Vote by Mail ballot is Oct. 29

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds L.A. County voters to request a Vote by Mail ballot by Tuesday, Oct. 29 for the Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections, which take place on Nov. 5, 2013.

To date, the RR/CC has mailed nearly 550,000 Vote by Mail ballots, accounting for over 30 percent of the eligible registered voters in L.A. County. There are over 1,744,000 eligible registered voters.

Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot is easy and can be done <u>online</u> or by using the back of the Official Sample Ballot. Registered voters can also apply in person at the RR/CC's main office: 12400 Imperial Hwy., 3rd floor, Room 3002, Norwalk, CA 90650.

L.A. County residents who applied for a Vote by Mail ballot can check the status of their ballot online.

Vote by Mail ballots must be received by the L.A. County RR/CC in Norwalk by 8 p.m. on Election Day. Voters can drop off or mail their ballot to RR/CC headquarters in Norwalk or drop their ballot off at any polling place in L.A. County on Election Day between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. Postmarked envelopes are not accepted.
